

Prices, terms and conditions

Tuition fee: Full fee: DKK 90,000 (**EURO 12,200**)

Terms of payment: The 1st instalment of tuition fee of DKK 63,000 is due no later than:

- 15 May 2019 for students from non-EU countries
- 1 August 2019 for students from EU countries

The 2nd instalment of tuition fee of DKK 27,000 is divided into two payments:

- DKK 13,500 to be paid no later than 1 February 2020
- DKK 13,500 to be paid no later than 15 March 2020

Withdrawal prior to 2nd semester

Students wishing to terminate enrolment prior to 2nd semester must notify the administration in writing to dmuenrolment@brock.dk prior to 1 January 2020 for 2nd semester. If no written notice, the student is liable for payment of that semester fee.

Failure to observe regular fee payment may lead to the immediate termination of student status.

Refunds:

Refunds apply only in below mentioned cases:

1. Residence Permit Refusals
 - If a student who has applied for a residence permit from his/her home country is not granted a residence permit, the deposited tuition fee, less a DKK 2,000 administration fee, will be refunded.
 - If a student who has applied for a residence permit from Denmark is not granted a residence permit two months after the induction, the deposited tuition fee, less a DKK 2,000 administration fee, will be refunded.
2. Withdrawal 30 days prior to the Induction
If students wish to withdraw from the programme written notice must be given to dmuenrolment@brock.dk minimum 30 calendar days prior to the induction.

Any refund request must be submitted at the latest 90 days after study start. In case the student does not file a refund request, they lose the right to any prepaid deposits to Niels Brock Copenhagen Business College.

Additional services:

Please note that some services are subject to a surcharge:

- Replacement of student card: DKK 50

Attendance:

Students must be active and therefore attend all classes in the study programme.

Please note that Niels Brock Business College is obligated by law to report inactive students to the Danish Immigration Authorities and as a consequence your residence permit may be revoked.
